

Your Upcoming Forest Memorial in Berkshires

ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE: Black Brook Road is closed until further notice

If you are coming from the South, it might direct you down this road. Please avoid it.

The closure is a 1/4 mile From Route 2, and if you take it, you will have to turn around and detour 30 minutes back.

Important things to know

- The entire forest is a non-smoking and non-vaping property for health and safety reasons. Due to forest service regulations, no sparks are allowed in the forest. This includes BBQs, candles, incense sticks and burning of sage. The fine from the USFS for this is up to \$5,000 per instance.
- Weather can change suddenly in the forest – we recommend layering with a warm jacket and long pants and wearing comfortable, closed-toe shoes as the forest trails can be wet and steep in some places.

What to expect

After your group gathers, we'll begin by gently combining your loved one's ashes with native forest soil. You're welcome to observe or participate as you wish.

We'll then make our way to the memorial tree. Walking sticks, and UTV are available upon request.

At the tree, the memorial will last about 30–60 minutes. Benches will be available, and guests are invited to help spread ashes and sow native wildflower seeds. You'll have private time at the tree before we conclude.

Afterward, you're welcome to explore the forest.
